Keeping pets calm on Bonfire Night

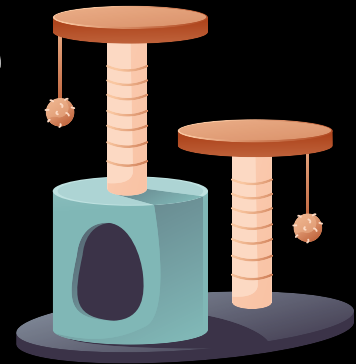


#1. Keep pets indoors

Ensure that your pets are safely indoors before the fireworks begin and keep doors, windows, and gates securely closed to prevent escape.

#2. Quiet & safe space

Create a safe and comfortable space your pet can retreat to when the fireworks start. Make sure it's stocked with their favourite toys, and blankets, well-ventilated and has some background noise like soft music to drown out the sounds of fireworks.



#3. Calm and comforting

Pets can pick up on your emotions, so try to remain calm and comforting during the fireworks. Reassure them with gentle petting and soothing words.

#4. Distraction

Engage your pets in play or activities that they enjoy to help divert their attention from the noise outside.



#5. Consult a vet

If your pet has an extreme fear of fireworks or displays severe anxiety during such events, consult a vet for advice. If necessary, they can prescribe medication or natural remedies to help your pet stay calm.
